Mary earned a music degree from Dominican University, an MDiv from Yale Divinity School, and a PhD in Hebrew Scripture and Early Christian Literature from Northwestern University. She has an abiding love for ministry and scripture and joined the staff as Pastoral Associate in 1997. Prior to working at Sheil, Mary put her degrees in music, ministry and scripture to use as both a campus minister and college and seminary professor of Scripture, ministry, preaching and spirituality.

Mary is the author of three books: *Mothers, Lovers, Priests, Prophets, and Kings: What the Old Testament Tells Us About God and Ourselves*, *Daybreaks: Daily Reflections for Advent and Christmas*, and *Remembering God: Resting in the Midst of Life* all published by Liguori Press, as well as numerous reflections and articles on the bible, lectionary readings, scripture, campus ministry, and young adults.
